



## Shelby County Chess 2009-2010

### GRAND SLAM CHESS SERIES

All grand slam series awards will be presented at the  
Shelby County Open and Scholastic Chess Championship  
April 10, 2010

#### OPEN TOURNAMENTS

- 1) Players will compete for cash prizes at each of the four Grand Slam Open tournaments.
- 2) The top three players who accumulate the most points over the entire series of Open tournaments will receive a Grand Slam Series Open prize. Players who move up from one division to another may carry their points with them. However, any prize will be awarded based on the division in which they played the most games.
- 3) The top two finishers in each section in each Grand Slam tournament will qualify for the 2010 Shelby County Chess (SCC) Closed Tournament to be held in May, 2010.
- 4) Every player who attends all four Grand Slam Series Open Tournaments will receive a special participant prize at the end of the series.

#### SCHOLASTIC TOURNAMENTS

- 1) Each of the top three winners in the four scholastic sections will receive a medal immediately after each of the four tournaments.
- 2) Each of the top three players in the four scholastic sections who accumulate the most points in their section over the entire Grand Slam Series of Scholastic Tournaments will receive a Grand Slam Series prize. Players who move up from one division to another may carry their points with them. However, any prize will be awarded based on the division in which they played the most games.
- 3) The top two finishers in each section in each Grand Slam tournament will qualify for the 2010 Shelby County Chess (SCC) Closed Tournament to be held in May, 2010.
- 4) All players who play in all four Grand Slam Series Scholastic Tournaments will receive a special prize at the end of the series.
